

THE BORDERS OF MADAGASCAR AND NOSY-BE ARE CLOSED



Following the address by the President of the Republic of Madagascar on 10 April 2021, and faced with the new wave of Covid-19, the borders of Madagascar and Island of Nosy-Be are again closed to international flights from 18 April 2021 until further notice.

Furthermore the Civil Aviation of Madagascar (ACM) expands the list of countries from which boarding of passengers to Madagascar **is not**

allowed to 43 countries.
