REOPENING OF THE BORDERS OF MADAGASCAR



The reopening of the borders of Madagascar to **international passengers** will be **gradual but limited**.

○ **Passengers from Europe** will be able to come to Madagascar, for the time being on **Air France** and **Air Madagascar** flights from **November 6, 2021**

○ **Nosy-Be** will also be able to accommodate international passengers but **only via (1) charter flights** as well as **via (2) cruise ships** from this date of **November 6, 2021**

○ Flights between Madagascar and the countries of the Indian Ocean islands will resume on **October 23, 2021**. These flights are operated by Air Austral for Reunion Island, and Air Mauritius for Mauritius.

○ **For the time being**, flights operated by the other companies which serve Madagascar, such as ***Ethiopian Airlines, Kenya Airways, or Turkish Airlines*** are **not yet operating**.

○ Note that a **mandatory PCR test**, at the traveler's expenses of 25 Euro, will be well performed **on arrival at Ivato airport and Nosy-Be airport**, and **confinement at the hotel (at the traveler's expenses!)** of **one**, at most **two days**, must be carried out until publication of test results.

○ However be aware: in case of a **positive result to PCR test**, a **14-day self-isolation at the hotel (at the traveler's expenses!)** will be then implemented.
